Married Catherine McIntyre. (She was tiny, busy & thrifty) Children Eli Kitchen, Reddin, Robert, Rudolphus, Jane,He went a brother-in-law's bale & lost all - mill etc. from comfortable circumstances. So pulled out & moved to Cuyaga N.Y. where born Will, Rebecca, Dave - no stayed long. By covered wagon along lapping waters (upon wagon) of Lake Erie to Oldstown Ohio where moved in with Tobias & lived until house (log) built near Lordstown that later became known as Weisell Corner where had wagon shop - Born Ruben Prospered - built nice house that can still be seen (west & a little s. of Lordstown about 2 miles - (where road tunns left as one slitely rite &

Prospered - built nice house that can still be seen (west & a little s. of Lordstown about 2 miles - (where road turns left as goes slitely rite & ahead is Weisell Corner on rite.) (Mate & Martha saw house & were at Corner.)

Michael always kept his violin above his work bench - and occasionally imbibed a bit 2 freely. He rested by enjoying the sunset with his violin at door of house - Did well financially.

Died there winter 1872 & buried at Lordstown where grave may be seen - Catherine & Jane continued to live on farm - Jane (at about 40) married & C. went to live with Lucinda (Parks) near Niles.
